

LICENSING

INITIAL LICENSE

- Resident
1. Obtain an Insurance Licensing Examination Candidate Guide (free of charge) by accessing www.ncdoi.com or www.pearsonvue.com
 2. Take 20 hours of pre-licensing courses for each line of authority, 10 hours for Medicare/LTC
 3. Applicants will receive an admission ticket in the Candidate Guide. The ticket will be completed at completion of training. Ticket must be taken to examination site.
 4. Apply for license at www.nipr.com
 5. Wait for authorization to schedule your exam from Pearson Vue.
 6. Schedule exam thru Pearson Vue, take and pass exam
 7. Get Fingerprinted within 30 days after applying for license (will receive instructions in email)
 8. Will receive email license was approved and will get instructions on how to print license.

Non-Resident: Apply at www.nipr.com (must be in good standing in home state)

RENEWALS

Resident and Non-Resident: Insurance agent licenses do not renew. Agent licenses are valid until surrendered, canceled or revoked. North Carolina will recertify nonresident agent licenses by reviewing their license status in their home state

Residents need to have 24 hours of CE completed, with 3 being in ethics, at least 30 before license expires.

North Carolina contd.

LONG TERM CARE REQUIREMENTS

All license holders wishing to sell Long Term Care, Long term Care-Partnership, and Med Supp in North Carolina must have the Long Term Care/Med Supp Line of Authority on their license. The Health LOA does not include LTC.

All Resident license holders must complete the following courses: (all count towards your state license CE requirements)

1. Initial 8 hour LTC Partnership Course, online or classroom
2. 4 hours of Renewal LTC courses every two years from date of initial 8 hour course. Online or classroom option.

Non residents must be compliant in their home state in order to write LTC.
