INITIAL LICENSE

- Resident
1. Complete 20 hour pre-licensing course for each line of authority
 2. Sign up to take state licensing exam, Take and pass exam www.pearsonvue.com
 3. Get Fingerprinted

LONG TERM CARE CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

All resident license holders wishing to sell Long Term Care, Long term Care-Partnership, and Med Supp must complete the following courses: (all count towards your state license CE requirements)

1. The Washington-state-approved courses are titled "WA LTC Initial 8-hour course".
2. "WA LTC Refresher 4-hour course" to be taken every 2 years. Online or classroom option.

Non residents must be compliant in their home state in order to write Washington LTC.
