**LICENSING** (please note that Wyoming's licensing website is in development stages)

## **INITIAL LICENSE**

- Resident
1. Does not require and pre-licensing courses but requires to pass exam. Can obtain Candidate's Handbook thru <http://www.pearsonvue.com/wy/insurance/> . Study materials can be found by going <https://sites.google.com/a/wyo.gov/doi/licensing/producers/resident> and scroll down to heading "Study materials are available from these vendors"
  2. Schedule and pass exam. Go to <http://www.pearsonvue.com/wy/insurance/> for information.
  3. After passing exam apply for license at [www.sircon.com](http://www.sircon.com) or [www.nipr.com](http://www.nipr.com) You will be charged a fingerprint and criminal background fee. You will received fingerprint cards in the mail.
  4. Once the Dept of Insurance receives the Criminal History check back they will process the application. This whole process may take up to 4 weeks.
- Non-Resident: Apply at [www.nipr.com](http://www.nipr.com) or [www.sircon.com](http://www.sircon.com) (must be in good standing in home state)

## **RENEWALS**

Resident and Non-Resident: [www.nipr.com](http://www.nipr.com) or [www.sircon.com](http://www.sircon.com)

Residents need to have 24 hours of CE, with 3 being in ethics, completed at least 30 days before license expires. No more than 12 hours by insurance sponsored CE. After completion of all 24 hours a form is required to be sent to the Dept of Insurance. This form is to be mailed to the Dept of Insurance prior to applying for renewed license. ### CONTINUING EDUCATION

**RESIDENT LICENSE CE'S:** 24 hours of CE, with 3 being in ethics, completed at least 30 days before license expires. No more than 12 hours by insurance sponsored CE. After completion of all 24 hours a form is required to be sent to the Dept of Insurance. This form is to be mailed to the Dept of Insurance prior to applying for renewed license. 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### **LONG TERM CARE CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS**

All resident license holders wishing to sell Long Term Care, Long term Care-Partnership, and Med Supp must complete the following courses: (all count towards your state license CE requirements)

1. Initial 8 hour LTC partnership Course, online or classroom
2. 4 hours of Renewal LTC courses every two years from date of initial 8 hour course. Online or classroom option.

Non residents must be compliant in their home state in order to write LTC.
