LICENSING

INITIAL LICENSE

- Resident
1. Create profile with state at MyProfile at https://dice.fldfs.com/public/pb_index.aspx
All information can be found here once you set up a login and password.
Basic steps are:
 - a. Complete 40 hours pre-licensing course.
 - b. Complete application thru MyProfile
 - c. Get fingerprinted
- Non-Resident: Same as resident but are exempt from pre-licensing courses. Must create login with MyProfile at https://dice.fldfs.com/public/pb_index.aspx

RENEWALS

- Resident: Licenses are perpetual however, resident license holders need to complete CE courses based on the license type, designation and years in business. For details please refer to: https://dice.fldfs.com/public/pb_cereq_srch.asp
- Non-Residents: Licenses are perpetual so no need to renew. However agent has to be compliant in home state.

CONTINUING EDUCATION

RESIDENT LICENSE CE'S: Please see above under Renewals

LONG TERM CARE CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

All resident license holders wishing to sell Long Term Care, Long term Care-Partnership, and Med Supp must complete the following courses: (all count towards your state license CE requirements)

1. Initial 8 hour partnership LTC Course, online or classroom
2. 4 hours of Renewal LTC courses every two years from date of initial 8 hour course. Online or classroom option.

Non residents must be compliant in their home state in order to write LTC.
