INITIAL LICENSE

- Resident
1. Complete 20 hours pre-licensing course per line of authority

 2. Take and pass exam. Contact / www.testingservices-ms.com or call (601) 956-0049
 3. Apply for license at www.sircon.com/mississippi . If applying for a first-time license or renewing an existing license through SIRCON, the pre-licensing or continuing education certificate may be faxed to (601) 359-1951 or emailed to licensing@mid.state.ms.us with a request for on-line approval.
- Non-Resident: Apply at www.sircon.com/mississippi (must be in good standing in home state)
