INITIAL LICENSE

- Resident
1. Sign up to take state licensing exam by contacting <http://www.pearsonvue.com/tx/insurance/>
Or calling PearsonVue at 888-754-7667
 2. Take and pass exam
 3. Get Fingerprinted
 4. Apply for license at www.sircon.com/texas
- Non-Resident: Apply at www.sircon.com/texas (must be in good standing in home state)
Submit a Certificate of Good Standing from home state

Residents need to have 30 hours of CE completed, with 2 being in ethics, at least 30 before license expires. Available courses can be found at www.sircon.com/texas.

NAIC REQUIRED: YES, in addition to the state required 8 hour course

LONG TERM CARE CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

All resident license holders wishing to sell Long Term Care, Long term Care-Partnership, and Med Supp must complete the following courses: (all count towards your state license CE requirements)

1. Initial 8 hour LTC partnership course, online or classroom. Found at www.sircon.com/texas
2. 4 hours of Renewal LTC courses every two years from date of initial 8 hour course. Online or classroom option.

Non residents must be compliant in their home state in order to write LTC.
